जवाहरलाल नेहरू



भारत महानों की भूमि है। यहाँ कई नेता भी पैदा हुए हैं। भारत भूमि पर देश भक्ति से भले लोगों का जन्म हुआ है। पंडित जवाहरलाल नेहरू भी ऐसे ही एक महान इन्सान थे। स्वतंत्र भारत के प्रथम प्रधान मंत्री बने। पंडित जवाहरलाल नेहरू का जन्म 14 नवम्बर 1889 ई. को इलाहाबाद में हुआ। इनके पिता श्री मोतीलाल नेहरू तथा माताजी श्रीमती स्वरूपनी थी। इनका परिवार बड़ा धनी परिवार था। इनकी प्रारंभिक शिक्षा घर में हुई। उच्च शिक्षा इंग्लैंड में हुई। सन् 1912 ई. में नेहरू जी भारत लौटे और वकालत करने लगे, उसी वर्ष से कांग्रेस से उनका संबंध बना। सन् 1919 ई. में गांधीजी दक्षिण अफ्रिका से भारत आये, तब से नेहरू जी उसके साथ मिलकर काम करने लगे। देश को सबकुछ मानने लगे। 'प्रिंस आफ केस' जब भारत आये तब नेहरू जी ने उनका विरोध किया। इसके लिए वे जेल भेजे गये। लगभग आठ बार उनको कैद किया गया। 15 अगस्त 1947 में भारत आजाद हुआ। पंडित नेहरू जी स्वतंत्र भारत के प्रथम प्रधान मंत्री बनाये गये। तब देश के सामने बहुत सारी समस्याएँ थी। भारत के निर्माण में नेहरूजी को अहम भूमिका रही। सन् 1964 तक ये प्रधान मंत्री रहे नेहरू जी विद्वान और महान लेखक भी थे। वे निडर और बहादुर थे। विश्व शांति पर जोर देते थे। हर ओर उन्नति को स्थान देना चाहते थे। पंडित जवाहरलाल नेहरू को बच्चों से बहुत प्यार था। जिसके कारण बच्चे चाचा नेहरू कह कर बुलाते थे। भारतवासी चाचा नेहरू को कभी भी भूल नहीं पायेंगे।
